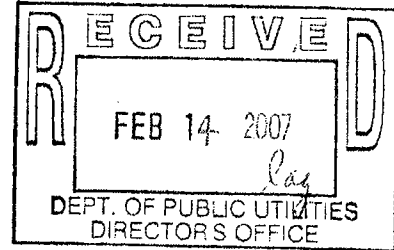

Dear Mr. Beschler:

This letter is intended to provide support for a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) for the area protected by the Richmond Water Purification Plant Local Protection Project, as requested by the City of Richmond Department of Public Utilities' letter dated January 31, 2007. This project was completed in 2000 and turned over to the City of Richmond, Virginia, for Operation and Maintenance. A LOMR was not prepared as part of the Federal project, since no private property is protected by the floodwall.

By this letter, I certify in accordance with 44 CFR Part 65.10(e), that the Local Protection Project at the Water Purification Plant, Richmond, Virginia, has been designed and constructed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to provide protection against flood events exceeding the base flood. The top of the floodwall is elevation 117 feet, NGVD, while the Base Flood Elevations mapped on Community Panel Number 510129 0005 B for the protected area are between 105 and 107 feet, NGVD.
